In the surroundings of the chosen picturesque location, you will create a sketch/drawing on paper using watercolours or pastels.

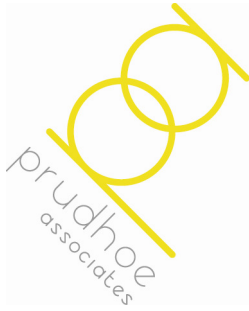
(During inclement weather, the session will be held indoors)
